A representative of British Gas, I've come to read your meter.

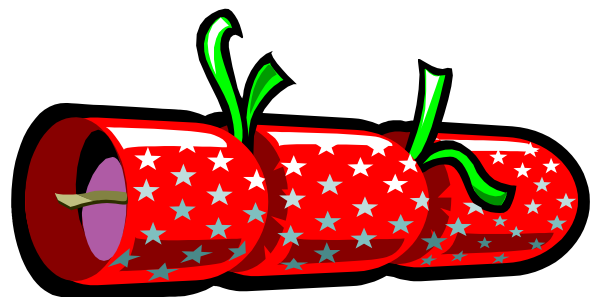
Do you have ID?

Oh good, come in.

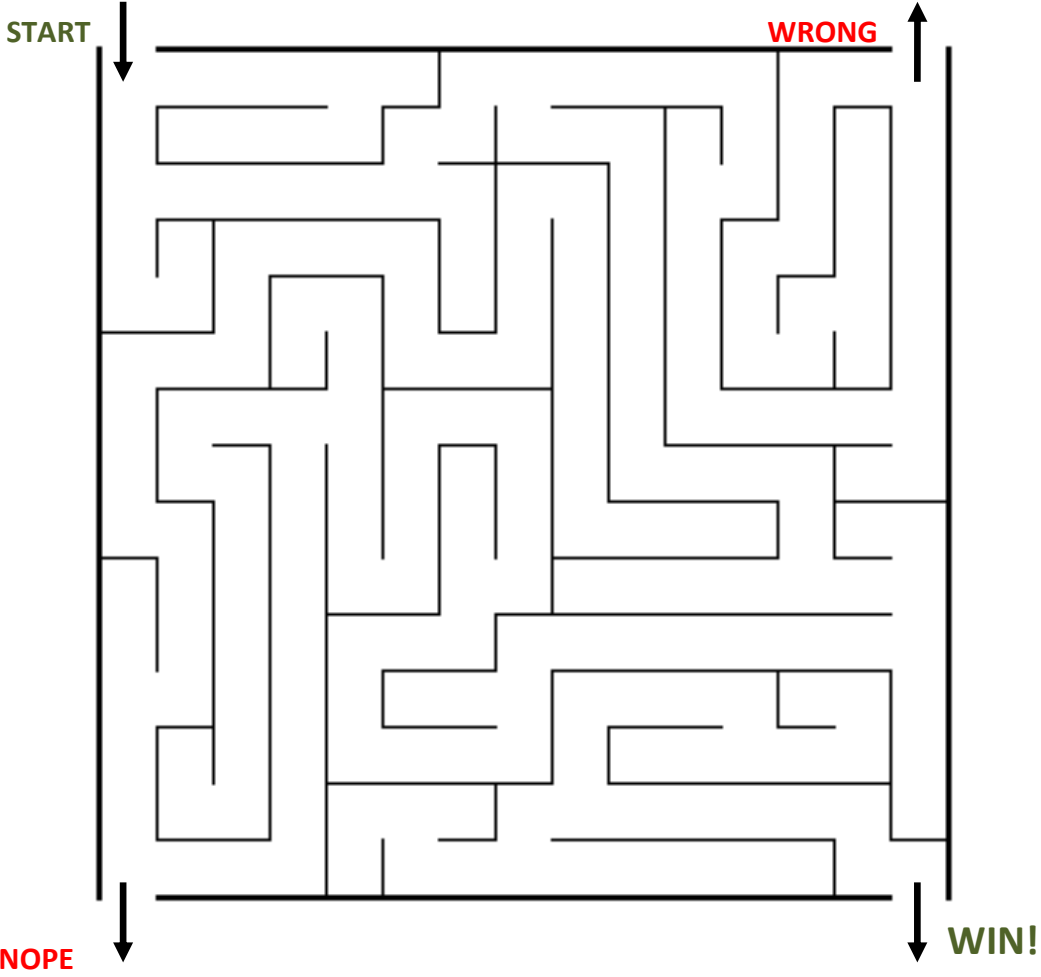

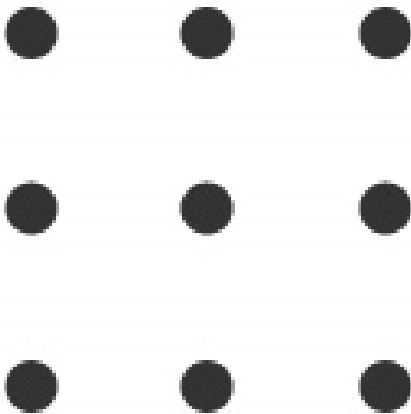
